## Reporting Model

Inverurie Market Place School is a school where everyone works together as a community to create an ethos where all the children are nurtured, respected, included, inspired and motivated in reaching their full potential, not only academically, but as confident individuals ready to actively grasp and follow their dreams in the future.

Through working in partnership with parents we have created a 'Reporting Model' to highlight, promote and share expectations of all the methods of reporting we use in school to ensure parents are fully informed and involved in their child's learning.

**Learning Newsletter:** Each term you will receive a newsletter outlining the class learning for each term.

**Year Report:** You will receive each year a report for your child detailing your child's attainment, progress in learning, strength and personal qualities and next steps in learning.

**Snapshot of a Week:** Each term you will receive your child's 'Snapshot Jotter' which will provide you with an insight into some of the learning activities your child takes part in and track your child's progress over the course of a year.

**Open Classroom and School Events:** You will have regular opportunities throughout the school year to view and take part in school and class events e.g. Open Classroom Events, Sports day, Christmas Singalong, Leavers Assembly, Poppy tea, Daffodil Tea. Open events aim to provide parents with an insight into the school day and celebrate learning achievements.



### School, Child and Parent/Carer Working in Partnership

**Parents Evening:** Twice a year you will have the opportunity to meet with your child's class teacher to discuss learning progress and how to support your child at home and in school.

**School Newsletters:** School newsletters will be sent home monthly providing you with educational development updates, school events and school life information.

**If at any point you have a concern or question please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher to arrange an appointment.**

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**Profiling:** Throughout the year each child will create a profile of their learning enabling you to track your child's progress and be informed as to how and what your child is learning.
