Run by our 2 friendly leaders, Gladys and Kaz, Breakfast Club takes place in the school dining room and is open from 7.30am for all children from nursery-P7.

Breakfast consists of a varied mix of nutritious foods: from cereals to toast, yoghurts and fruit and sometimes even pancakes if you're lucky! We always manage to cater for even the fussiest of little customers! After breakfast we encourage children to brush their teeth, then its time for fun, with a wide range of activities on offer from crafts to board games and a large mix of toys. We also provide seasonal activities during certain times of the year.

Some parents use Breakfast Club on set days every week, others book ad hoc days when the need arises and when space is available.

Breakfast Club provides a safe and friendly environment giving parents the reassurance that they can make an early start to the day with their children already comfortable at school.

Our leaders are both checked PVG scheme members with additional qualifications in first aid, food hygiene, child psychology and child protection. They both have a fantastic rapport with the children and the close knit group has a friendly atmosphere with brilliant integration between the different year groups.
